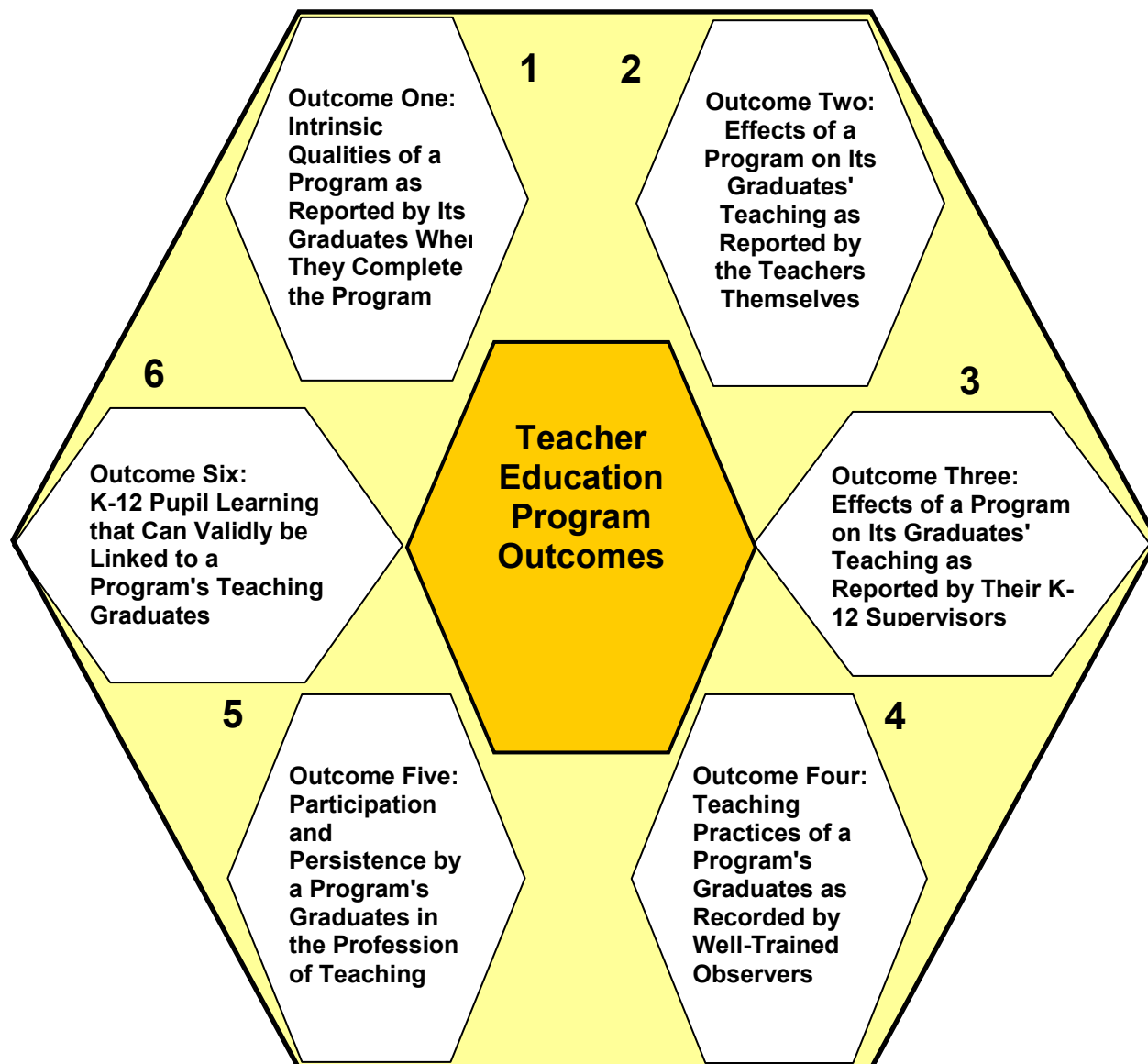

The CSU Mosaic: Multiple Significant Outcomes of Teacher Education Programs to be Measured, Assessed and Strengthened Over Multiple Years

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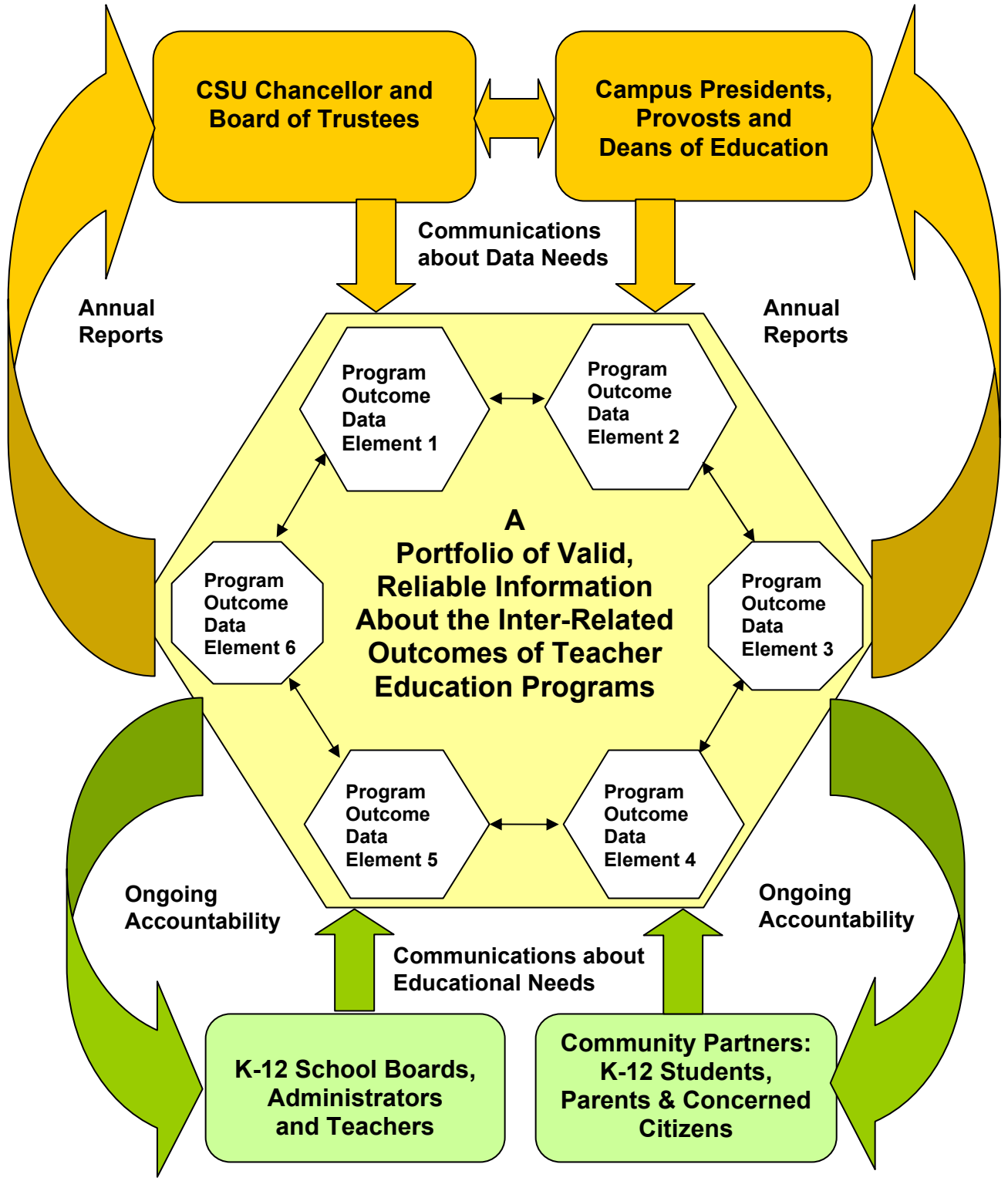


Question A: Are there other important outcomes of teacher education programs that should be included in the CSU Mosaic?

Question B: What adjustments would be needed in the Mosaic for it to become a valuable planning tool for other institutions?

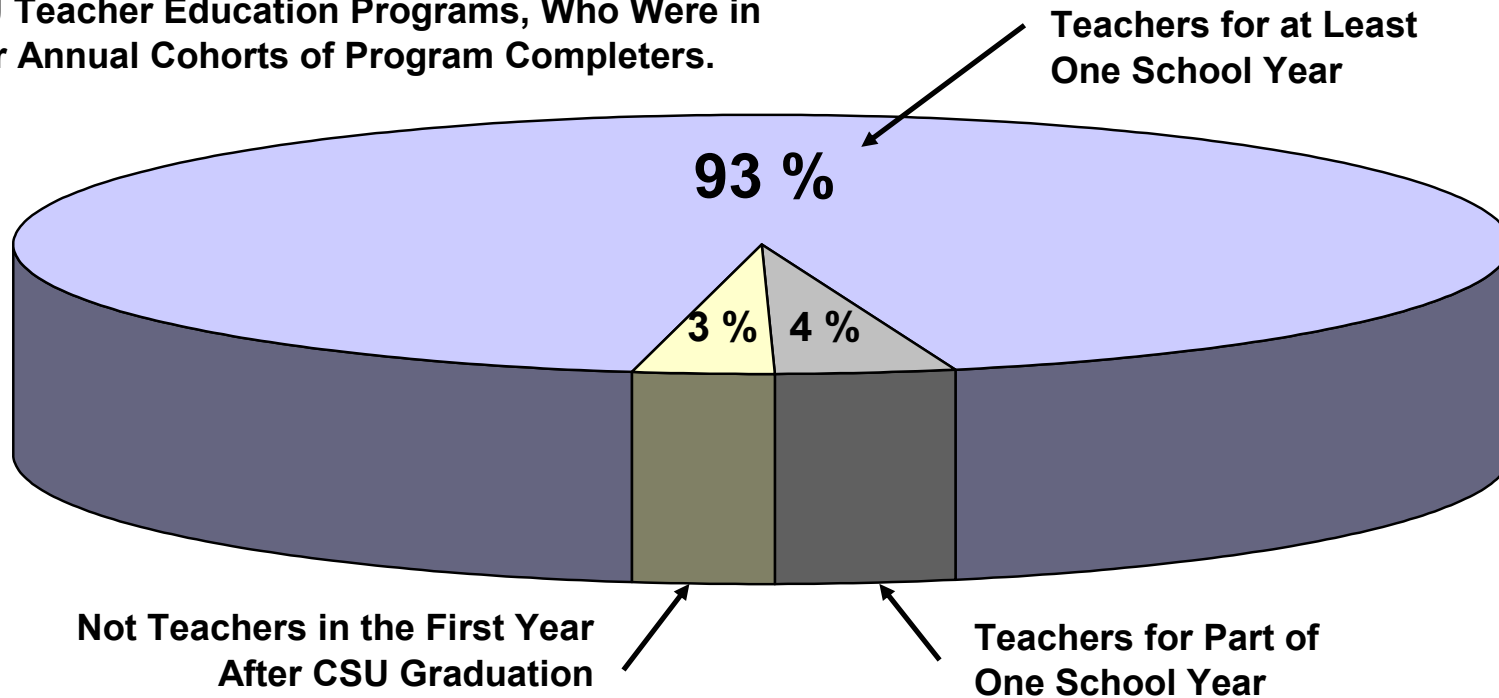

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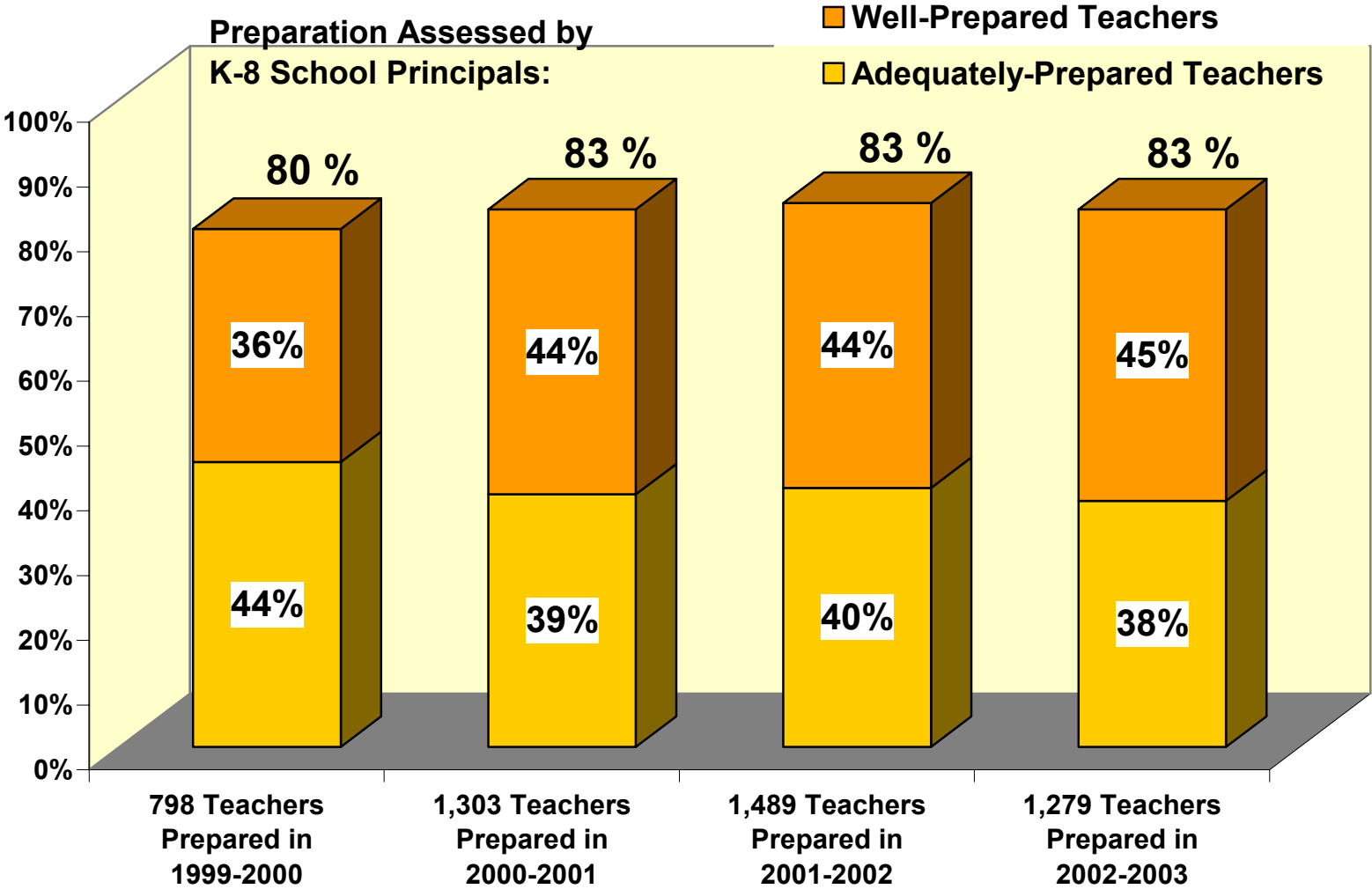


CSU Findings Related to Program Outcome 5: CSU Credential Graduates Become Teachers

The Evaluation Located 42,106 Graduates of CSU Teacher Education Programs, Who Were in Four Annual Cohorts of Program Completers.



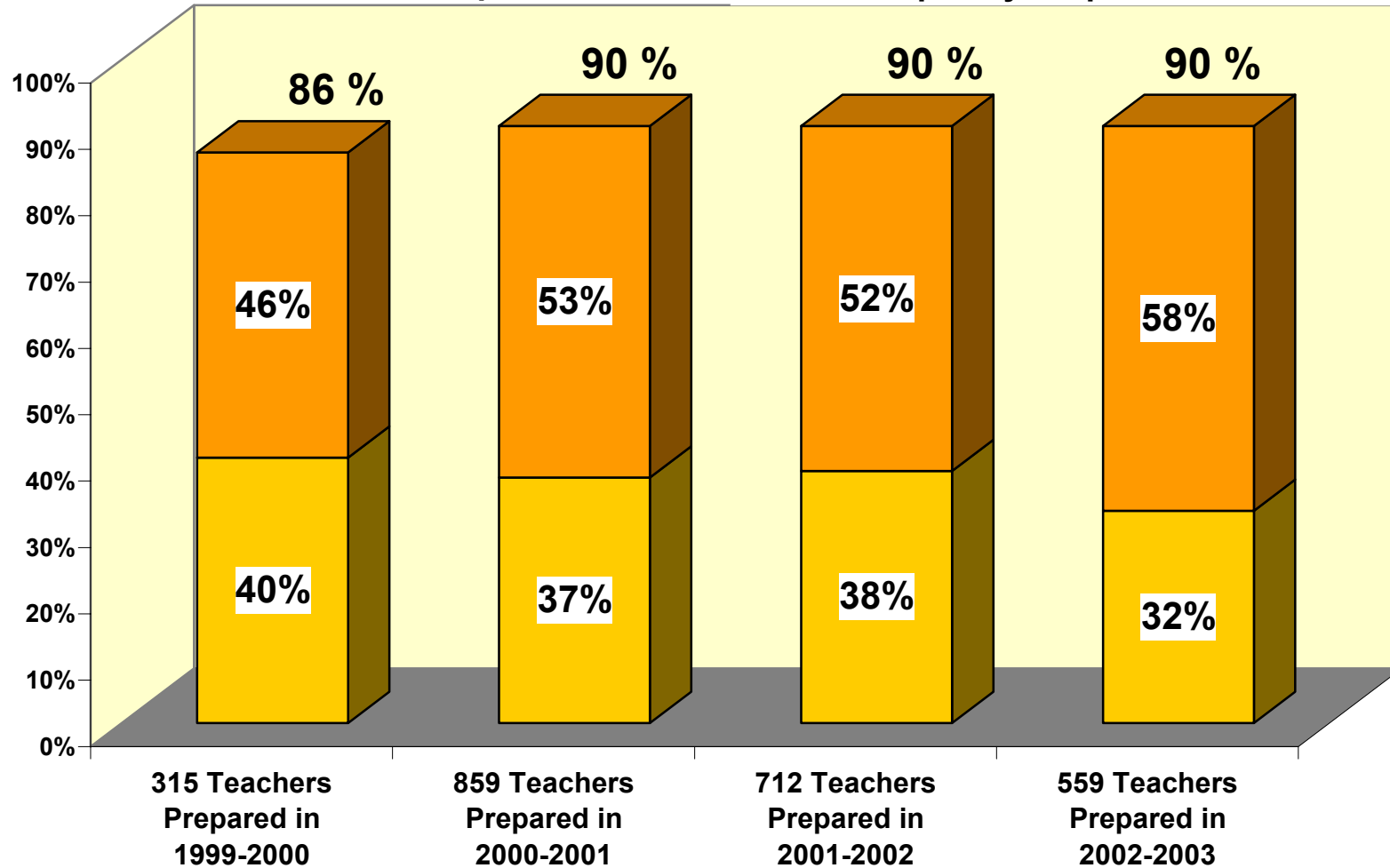
**CSU Findings Related to Program Outcome Three:

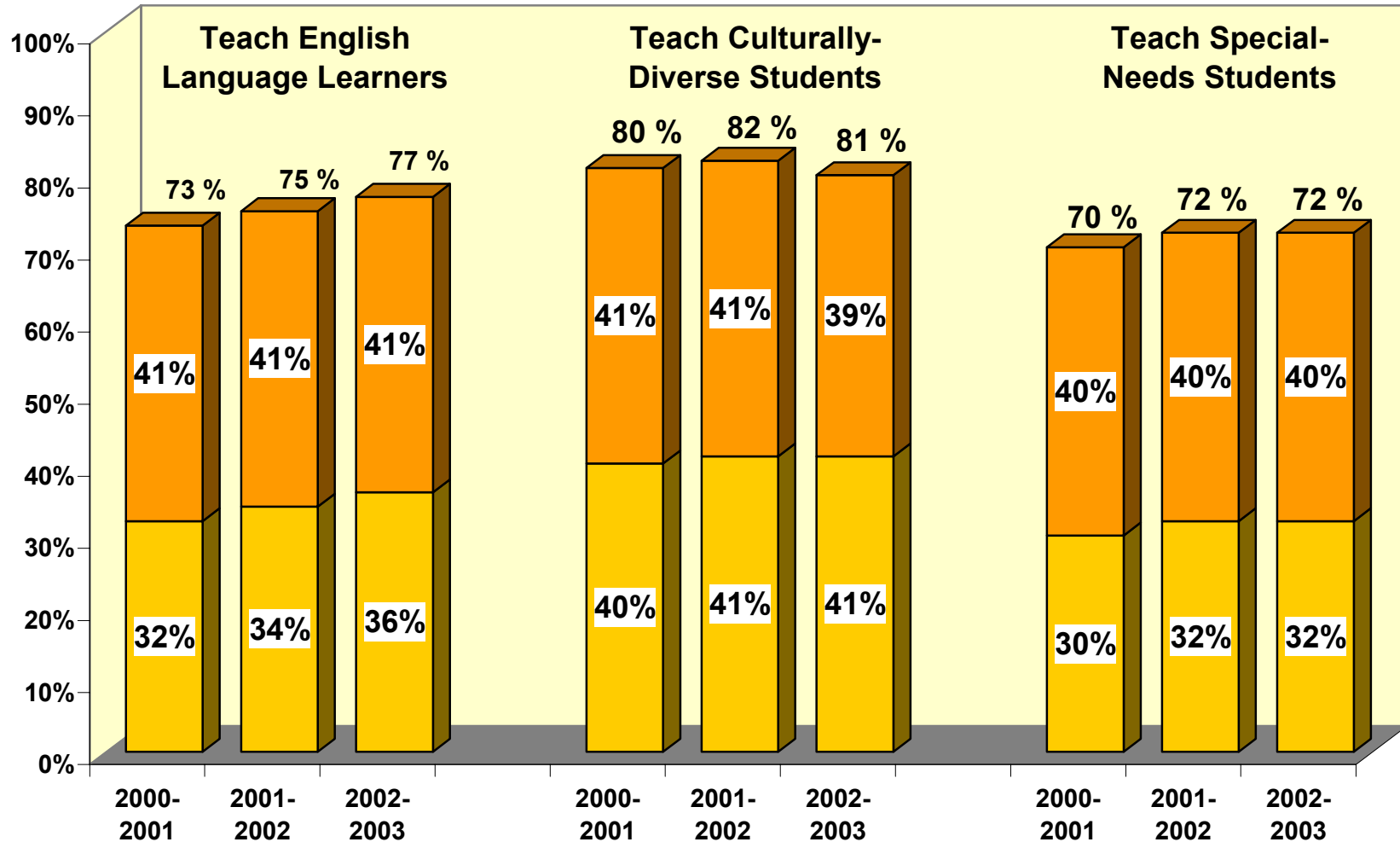

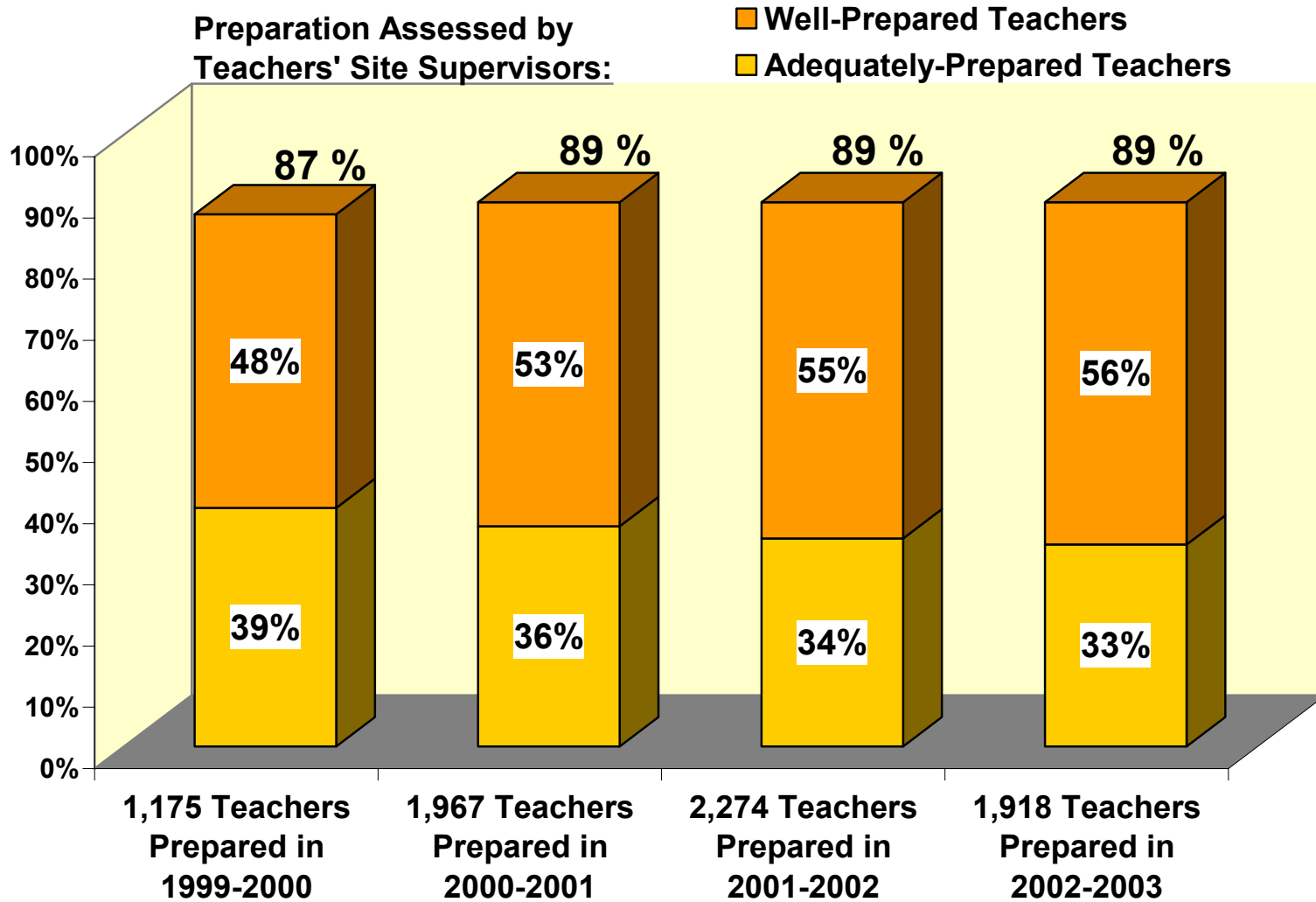
CSU Prepares Teachers for Student Diversity: K-12

■ Well-Prepared Teachers

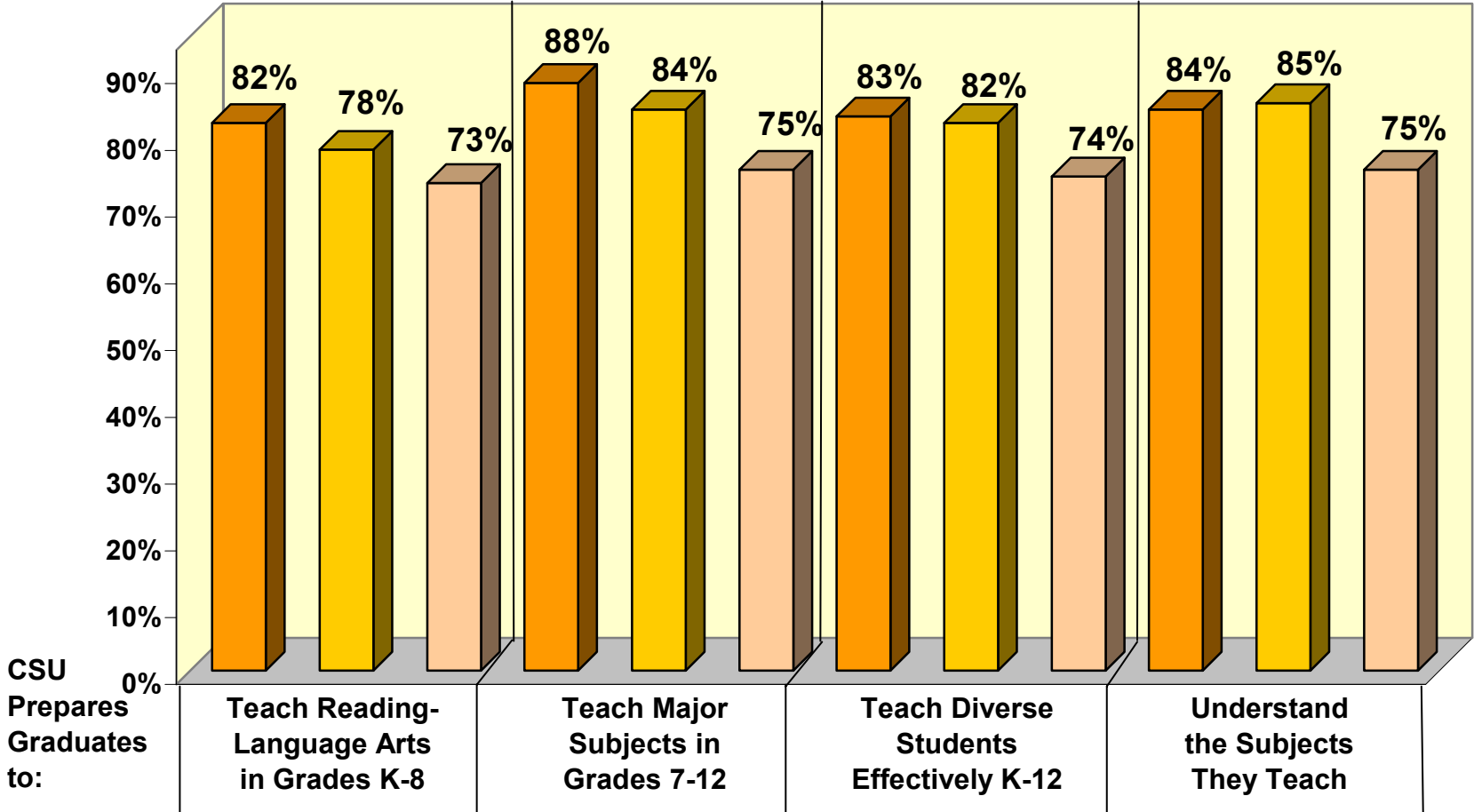


CSU Prepares Credential Graduates to Know and Understand the Grade-Level Subjects They Teach
